Big Brother, Idris Oladipo, and Little Brother, Isaiah, kicked off the event by speaking to our golfers about the successes of their match.

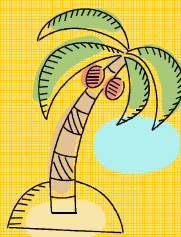
